

## **Inviting Expressions of Interest from the local NGOs to be partners of BRAC Afghanistan Education Program for implementing community based education.**

**Context:** BRAC Afghanistan Education Program implements a girls' education project supported by CIDA with the objectives to supplement the government efforts in ensuring universal primary education for all following the MDG. This is a four year project has stated in January 2007 and will be completed in December 2010.

Within this period the project will provide education to 1 20,000 out of school children among them over 80% girls, provide subject based training on English, Science, Mathematics and Computer subject to 3,800 government school teachers, develop 5,000 adolescent members through providing livelihood and life-skills training, carry out study to identify the barriers in girls' education and study to assess the effectiveness of subject based training provided by BRAC Afghanistan Education Program and carry out new initiatives on Early Childhood development by operating pre-primary schools.

The project carries out the stated functions through its some components of which one is capacity development of local NGOs by involving in Community Based School (CBS) operation.

**Objectives of local NGOs' involvement in Partnership CBS operation:** to develop the capacity of local NGOs on CBS operation, so that the children especially over aged out of school children of the remote rural areas can access in education.

**Key tasks for the Local NGOs to be carried out as partners of BRAC Afghanistan Education Program:**

- Community based school establishment and operation following the policy and operational manual of BRAC Partnership Education Program along with following the terms and conditions of the Girls' Education Project.
- Low cost classroom construction through ensuring community contribution and involving local education departments and following guidelines of BRAC Partnership Education Program.

**Expression of Interest** is invited from the local NGOs working in the provinces of Urusgan, Ghor, Daikundi, Bamyan, Gazni, Nooristan, Paktia, Paktika, Khost, Kunar and Wardak.

**Necessary papers and documents need to submit:**

- A one Page letter showing justification on interest to be partners.
- Organizational profile mentioning legal status (Registration) and experience on the proposed activities.
- Yearly budget of the organization ( 2007 and 2008)
- Key staff background.
- Hard copy of Audit Report 2008.
