Turquoise Mountain

Turquoise Mountain was founded in March 2006 as a non-profit, governmental organization, with the support and patronage of HE Hamid Karzai, The President of Afghanistan, and HRH Prince Charles, The Prince of Wales. TM aims to preserve cultural heritage, improve living conditions and create economic opportunities through its investment in Afghanistan's traditional crafts, historic building and landscapes. TM's twin mission of cultural preservation and economic regeneration is designed to help strengthen a sense of national pride and identity and restore a connection to Afghanistan's rich cultural history.

Urban Regeneration in Murad Khane

The site, Murad Khane lies on the northern bank of Kabul River, south of the Presidential Palace. It is one of the last remaining sections of the old city on the north side of the river and home to several buildings that are of central importance to Afghan architectural traditions and is a centre for local artisan trade. From the 1970's to the 1990's much of the original infrastructure of Murad Khane was lost through demolition and forced clearance. Streets and alleys were buried under decades worth of garbage, as deep as two metres in some places. Rain and snow leaked into the foundations of these historic buildings, weakening them to the point of collapse. Turquoise Mountain is undertaking a comprehensive regeneration programme in Murad Khane. It is restoring historic building, stabilizing private houses and improving basic infrastructure by clearing rubbish, levelling and paving streets and installing sewerage, water, and electricity supplies. So far Turquoise Mountain has removed 15,000 cubic metres of rubbish, lowering street levels by over two metres. The stabilisation of 50 dilapidated family homes, the installation of street drains, wells and toilets has benefited public health as well as the urban environment. This provides a firm foundation for wider social and economic

transformation. Turquoise Mountain is also providing essential health and education services to the community.

Turquoise Mountain Institute for Afghan Arts and Architecture

In 2006, Turquoise Mountain established an internationally accredited Institute for Afghan Arts & Architecture to train a new generation of artisans, to revive and restore threatened traditions, and harness the potential that already exists in Afghanistan. The Institute is led by the country's leading master artisans and it is rapidly becoming the leading arts institution in the country. It is now established as the City and Guilds centre for Afghanistan and has been registered with the Afghan Ministry of Education as a national institution for the traditional arts. As part of a programme of urban regeneration Turquoise Mountain are moving the Institute for Afghan Arts & Architecture into in a complex of buildings comprised of existing and new-build structures in Murad Khane.
