Procurement of Works for: (Construction of Behsood Cricket Ground-Canal in Nangarhar Province).

- 1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in Development Business published on **02 /April/2019**
- 2. The Islamic Republic of Afghanistan Cricket Board has received a grant from the International Cricket Council (ICC)toward the cost of Afghanistan Cricket Board (ACB), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this *grant* to payments under the Contract for the Sub project packages/lots given in Para 3 below.
- 3. The Procurement Management Department, acting on behalf of the Afghanistan Cricket board, now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the following package/lots, the construction period is 270 days which includes slack period of 60 days for flood/adverse weather conditions and resolving Construction etc.
- 4. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the ACB's Guidelines: Procurement under ICC Credits, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Bidding Documents.

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6. Qualifications requirements include:

- (a) The minimum required annual volume of construction work for the successful bidder in any of the last five years is **7,690,000** Afghani.
 - (a) Experience as prime contractor in the construction of at least one works of nature and complexity equivalent to this work during the last five (5) years is **4,614,000** Afghani.
- (b) Proposals for the timely acquisition (own, lease, hire, etc.) of the essential equipment as given in the bidding document.
- (c) Contract Manager with five years' experience in works of an equivalent nature and volume, including no less than three years as Manager.
- (e) Liquid assets and/or credit facilities, net of other contractual commitments and exclusive of any advance payments which may be made under the Contract 1,922,500 Afghani.

For detailed post qualification verification please refer to Section I - Instructions to Bidders and Section II- Bid Data Sheet of the bidding documents.

A margin of preference for eligible national contractors/joint ventures shall not be applied.

7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be obtain free of charge by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below.

The Bidding Documents shall be collected by the bidders from the address below.

- 8. The bidders or their authorized representatives are invited to attend a pre-bid meeting which will take place on 21-April-2019, at 11:00 AM in the Procurement Management at the address given below to explain the procedure of proper preparation and submission of bid, clarify issues and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage.
- 9. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 11:00 AM of 01-May-2019 (if this date is announced an official holiday, then bids must be submitted next working day at the same time and venue). Electronic bidding shall not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at 11:00 AM of 01-May-2019.
- 10. All bids shall be accompanied by a "Bid Security" of amount 300,000 Afghanis.
