2. The Ministry of Agriculture, Irrigation and Livestock now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for **Procurement of Goods for Supply of Winter Pest Management for Horticulture Component of NHLP/MAIL**<sup>2</sup>.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers [insert correct title and date of applicable Guidelines edition as per legal agreement] ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines.
