Fhi360-USWDP is looking for eligible and registered carpenters that specialize in furniture production to produce, deliver and install locally made furniture at **Jawzjan University** as per specifications included in Annex 1.

I. Items Specifications

See Annex 1 for detailed specifications.

II. Minimum Eligibility Requirements Vendors

To qualify for this RFQ, the vendor must:

- Hold a valid business license
- Be direct suppliers of locally made furniture with the production facility/workshop of their own. Subcontracting is not allowed for this work, so logistics companies should not apply for the RFQ as their proposals will be rejected right away. Site visit will be conducted to confirm that the vendor specialized in the carpentry work and has existing workshop.
- Accept all FHI 360 terms and conditions included in Annex 1, and complete the table in <u>Annex 1</u> of this RFQ.
- Have the ability to provide sample furniture from the scope for review and approval within one week. Only
 vendors in the top final list will be approached for sample requests. Vendors that delay the production of
 samples and produce poor quality samples will be rejected.

III. Evaluation Criteria

Vendors whose offer meets minimum technical specifications established in Section I and II and samples will eb acceptable, will be proposed for the evaluation and selected based on the lowest price. Therefore, please provide your best and final offer.

IV. Submission Requirements

The vendors have only one available options to submit quotations:

- a) Electronic Submission: Please email your offers to <u>uswdp-response@uswdp.org</u> by the designated deadline. Please indicate **RFQ-004320-2-** in the subject line of the email.
- All Quotations must be **<u>signed and/or stamped</u>** by an authorized representative.
- Vendors can submit their prices in their quotation format, but **Annex 1 must be completed** (mandatory).
- Quotations must provide a complete address, telephone number and e-mail address (if applicable) of the company.
- Quotations should be submitted in USD

V. <u>Tax</u>

Withholding Tax on Subcontractor:

Government withholding Tax: Pursuant to Article 72 in the Afghanistan Tax law effective March 21, 2009, USWDP/FHI360 is required withhold "contractor" taxes from the gross amount payable to all Afghan for-profit subcontractor/vendors with aggregate amount of AFN 500,000.00 or greater and transfer this to the Ministry of Finance. In accordance with this requirement, USWDP/FHI360 shall withhold 2% tax from all gross invoices from subcontractors/vendors under this Agreement with active AISA or Ministry of Commerce License. For subcontractors /vendors without active AISA or Ministry of Commerce license, USWDP/FHI360 shall withhold seven percent 7% "contractor" tax per current Afghanistan Tax law.

 - (3) No attempt has been made or will be made by the offeror to induce any other concern or individual to submit or not to submit an offer for the purpose of restricting competition or influencing the competitive environment.






