Synopsis	of the	Pre-qualification	Application
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1. Introduction and Purpose

1.1 Purpose

DAI, implementer of the USAID-funded Strong Hubs for Afghan Hope and Resilience (SHAHAR) project, invites qualified construction companies to submit applications to serve as pre-qualified firms in support of the Municipal Incentive Fund (MIF) projects' implementation.

The objective of the Strong Hubs for Afghan Hope and Resilience (SHAHAR) Program is to create wellgoverned, fiscally sustainable Afghan municipalities capable of meeting the needs of a growing urban population. SHAHAR intends to support to 10 expansion Municipalities (Puli Alam, Ghazni, Maydan Shahar Chaharickar, Puli Khomri, Aybak, Mymana, Qalat, Lashkar Gah and Qala-e-Naw) municipalities across Afghanistan, as well as the General Directorate of Municipal Affairs (GDMA) and Municipal Advisory Boards (MABs), will lead to improve municipal financial management, urban service delivery, and citizen participation in municipal governance.

One of the key emphases of SHAHAR is on strengthening the capacity of municipal governments in providing essential public services to their citizens, including increased access to vital infrastructure facilities. While previous programs, including the Regional Afghan Municipalities Program for Urban Populations (RAMP UP), SHAHAR's predecessor, achieved considerable advancement in this area, in significant infrastructure deficits still persist in all Afghan municipalities. To alleviate the poor infrastructure conditions in municipalities, SHAHAR will establish Municipal Incentive Fund for revenue generation project's mechanism (MIF) that can be tapped by all SHAHAR municipalities, through a competitive process, for the procurement of infrastructure and service delivery projects, including, but not limited to solid waste management, roads, sidewalks, transportation, streetlights, drainage, markets, public parks.

The MIF is likewise viewed as a vehicle for achieving other key objectives of the program. Among these objectives is to strengthen the roles of women, youth, and other traditionally marginalized groups in urban governance and improve their access to essential public services. Another objective is to spur local economic development by paving the way for increased private-sector involvement.

MIF as an infrastructure-funding mechanism will be available to only 10 municipalities, identified above.

1.2 Types of Infrastructure Projects

Through this application process, SHAHAR will pre-qualify construction firms, who will then be eligible to receive Request for Proposals (RFPs) for design and/or implementation of MIF infrastructure projects including, but not limited to, the following areas:

- Upgrading and Renovation of Roads (General Road Survey & Design)
- Upgrading and Renovation of Parks
- Upgrading and Renovation of Public Latrine
- Upgrading and Renovation of Canal (Medium)
- Upgrading and Renovation of Culverts
- Upgrading and Renovation of Car Parking Lots
- Upgrading and Renovation of Bus Terminal and Mini Bus Taxi Station
- Upgrading and Renovation of Women Parks

- Geographic experience in one of more of the 10 MIF municipalities listed in Section 1.3.
- d. Summary of organizational management and financial capacity.

iv. CVs for all senior managers and engineering/construction management/design staff

v. Organizational chart

- vi. A minimum of 3 Completion Certificates from previous clients and donors must be included with the application to document positive past performance.
- vii. Additional Reference letters may be provided.

viii. Copy of AISA license

ix. DUNS number
