- 4. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the ACB's Guidelines: Procurement under ICC Credits, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Bidding Documents.

Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 02:00 PM of 20-Aug-2019 (if this date is announced an official holiday, then bids must be submitted next working day at the same time and venue). Electronic bidding shall not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at 02:00 PM of 20-Aug-2019.
