The **Ministry of Agriculture, Irrigation & Livestock (MAIL)** has received a grant from the Afghanistan Reconstruction Trust Fund (ARTF) toward the cost of the [National Horticulture and Livestock Project], and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract¹ for [Execution of 1000 Improved Backyard Poultry Farms (30 Layer Birds Each) for ultra-poor village women in Trinkut (Center), Giezab, Dehrawoud and Chura districts of Urozgan province of Afghanistan]². For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing. ”]
2. The [National Horticulture and Livestock Project] now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for [Execution of 1000 Improved Backyard Poultry Farms (30 Layer Birds Each) for ultra-poor village women in Trinkut (Center), Giezab, Dehrawoud and Chura districts of Urozgan province of Afghanistan].³.
3. The contract implementation period is: **Twelve (12) months, 14 days later from date of signing of contract.**
4. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers -" *[insert date of*
