For Purchase of Construction Material:

Aga Khan Agency for Habitat, Afghanistan invites Bids for Purchase of **Cement, Gabion and Wire** with the following details:

No.	Description of Materail	Description	Quantity
1	Cement (Ordinary Cement of Grade 53)	Charat Made in Pakistan	8,274 Bags
2	Gabion Boxes of Size (2x1x1)	10 Tara Anti Rust	4,500 Boxes
3	Wire 3mm for Gabion Boxes	Anti Rust	900 Kg

1. Cement- Cherat Portland Ordinary Cement of Grade 53 (سمنت چرات پاکستانی)

The cement shall be ordinary Portland cement and shall be Pakistan

The cement shall be fresh, dry and in very good quality.

When stored in bags these shall be raised 30 cm above the ground and stacked in rows of 10 bags high, 60 cm clear from the walls, in dry place such that it will be efficiently protected from moisture and contamination, and that the consignments can be used up in the order in which they are received.

Cement shall be delivered on the site in bags with an unbroken seal fixed by the makers and plainly marked with the name of brand and the manufactured.

2. Gabion (2m x 1m x 1m)- 10 Tara Anti Rust (گبیون بکس ۱۰ تاره ضد زنگ)

The gabion boxes shall have hexagonal woven mesh with a maximum size of 10 cm x 12 cm, with the joints fanned by twisting each pair of wires through three half turns.

Sufficient binding and tie wires, horizontal and vertical bracers, and other accessories needed for the assembly and erection of the gabion works shall be supplied, at no additional cost, by the Contractor.

All wire used in the manufacture of gabion boxes and in the wiring operations during construction shall be heavily coated with zinc.

All edges of the gabion boxes including end-panel and diaphragms shall be mechanically selvage in such a way to prevent unraveling of the mesh.

Diaphragms shall be supplied to divide each gabion unit into cells to control movement of fill material within the gabion.

Any damages to the wire or coatings during assembly, the placement and filling should be repaired immediately.

Criteria:

- Proponents must acknowledge and understand the procurement rules, regulations, and procedures of the Owner (Aga Khan Agency for Habitat)
- Goods should confirm to the standards and their intended purpose, based on AKAH's samples
- Prices should be all inclusive of taxes, customs, delivery, offloading etc
- Valid account number and bank card would be required should the Proponent is selected
- Payment by the Owner will be through bank transfer only
- Proponent acknowledges that a 2% of the total cost as a security deposit will be required upon signing the Contract
