

Welthungerhilfe (WHH) in **Balkh** is recruiting a
Nutrition Trainer (Male & Female) – (Service Contract-short term (3months))

Welthungerhilfe it is one of Germany's biggest non-governmental relief organizations. Non-profit making, politically independent and non-denominational, the organization is run by a Supervisory Board of honorary members under the patronage of the President of the Federal Republic of Germany. Its work is funded by private donations and public grants. Welthungerhilfe is working since the 1980's continuously in Afghanistan and opened the first offices in 1992. Since this time Welthungerhilfe has implemented some 165 projects in Afghanistan. Main fields of Welthungerhilfe intervention in Afghanistan are emergency relief, food and nutrition security, rural and regional development and water and sanitation.

Partners in Revitalization and building (PRB) is a well-established, local NGO founded in 1990. PRB works in the areas of Agriculture, livestock and income generating activities, sustainable community development, environmental protection, animal health and natural resource management, particularly in northern and western Afghanistan.

Recently PRB got partnership with WHH for implementing a multi-sectorial project Linking Agriculture and Natural Resources Management toward improved food security, Advocacy and resilience strengthening through LANN+ in Afghanistan.

OBJECTIVES OF THE POSITION

PRB works in 6 districts Dehdadi and Marmol in Balkh province, Sheberghan and Khuja Dokoh in Jawzjan and Firoz Nakhchir and Hazrat-e- Sultan in Samangan province and one of the activities in the communities of the mentioned districts is to provide regular capacity development program on nutrition behavior change. In order to initiate with this piece of work, PRB is seeking to recruit a qualified male/or female trainer in the capacity of individual consultant to a) develop four training modules, b) to adapt LANN practitioner manual of PLA cycle (that consists 17-21 sessions) into Afghanistan context which already has been developed by WHH in the other countries and c) to develop related IEC materials including booklets...etc. in order to be used during PLA cycle meetings

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Duties and responsibilities:

Developing four training modules

- Developing four training modules (Adapt and adjust the existed training module with coordination of MoPH/PND recommendation and available resources). The training modules consist of 4 modules and each consist of below details;
1. Module 1 will cover IYCF (infant and young child feeding) practices, including the initiative of the first 1000 days of life
 2. Module 2 will cover health care practices during pregnancy (antenatal care), birth and postnatal care, family planning awareness and contraceptive promotion
 3. Module 3 covers topics such as food groups, balanced diets, cooking demonstrations and micronutrients
 4. Module 4 will deal with water-borne diseases and the way water is handled, hygiene and sanitation practices and focuses on the management of menstrual hygiene
 - The developed training modules must be in line with recommendation and standards set by MoPH and WHO

- The training manuals should be adapted from existing training manuals and guidelines developed by MoPH, WHO and resources available by WHH (LANN+ user guideline and resources)

Adaptation of existing LANN practitioner manual of PLA cycle meetings

- To adapt content of LANN practitioner manual of PLA cycle meetings in according to the developed training modules and Afghanistan context (the practitioner manual of PLA cycle meetings is already developed by WHH and exists within LANN toolkit). The toolkit would be made available by PRB
- To include key messages of Nutrition in Qur'an (NiQ) into the practitioner manual of PLA cycle meetings (the key messages would be made available to consultant by PRB)
- To ensure the methodologies used in the practitioner manual of PLA cycles are applicable in Afghanistan context, otherwise the methodologies should be adapted

Developing IEC materials

- To develop and design IECs (poster, brochure, and booklet) in according to the developed modules and useable on the PLA cycle meetings
- The IECs should be developed on the way that is friendly for those with limited literacy capacity and to be use in the rural areas by women

Overall responsibilities

- To develop all materials (training modules, practitioner manual on PLA cycle meetings and IECs) in the English language
- To translate all materials (training modules, practitioner manual on PLA cycle meetings and IECs) into local language (Dari) after the English version is approved by PRB
- To provide ToT to the PRB staff and Nutrition trainers on the developed tools (training modules and PLA cycle). The training cost, venue, food, refreshment...etc. for the participants would be cover by PRB

Obligation of WHH/PRB

- PRB will not cover the cost of accommodation, transportation, and other required facilities of the consultant
- PRB will not bear any responsibility for security issues but the contractor is obliged to adhere to the security rules of PRB
- PRB will make the payment once the assignment deliverables are obtained and approved and TOT is delivered
- PRB will deduct tax from the gross amount as per tax law of Afghanistan Islamic Republic
- PRB will set the duration for TOT and the consultant is agreed with the time duration. A detailed TOT is expected to be delivered

JOB REQUIREMENT:

Bachelor's degree with three years of training experience in the related field is expected

Medical background/ nutritionist or master's degree on the same field is an added value

It is expected that the applicant to be familiar with the Afghanistan health system including nutrition policies and strategies

Excellent oral and written communication skills and fluency both in Dari and English
