Oversight Commission on Access to Information
(OCAI)

Background

- Law was signed off by President Ghani in December 2014
- 6 Chapters and 32 Articles
- The OCAI was formed in July 2015



Combination of the OCAI

Article 16 of ATI Law:

- 4 Government representatives
- Representatives of AIHRC, AIBA, ALU, Journalists Union (2), CSOs (2), political parties, and ACCI





Mandate of the Commission

Article 19 of ATI Law:

- Oversight on ATI process
- Addressing complaints
- Advice to Government institutions
- Report to the President and the Parliament
- Awareness raising
- Development of legal framework



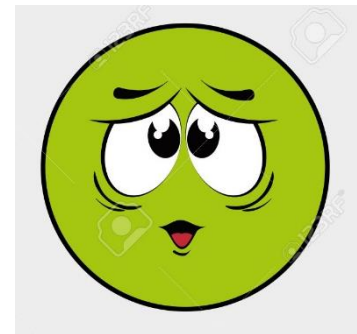

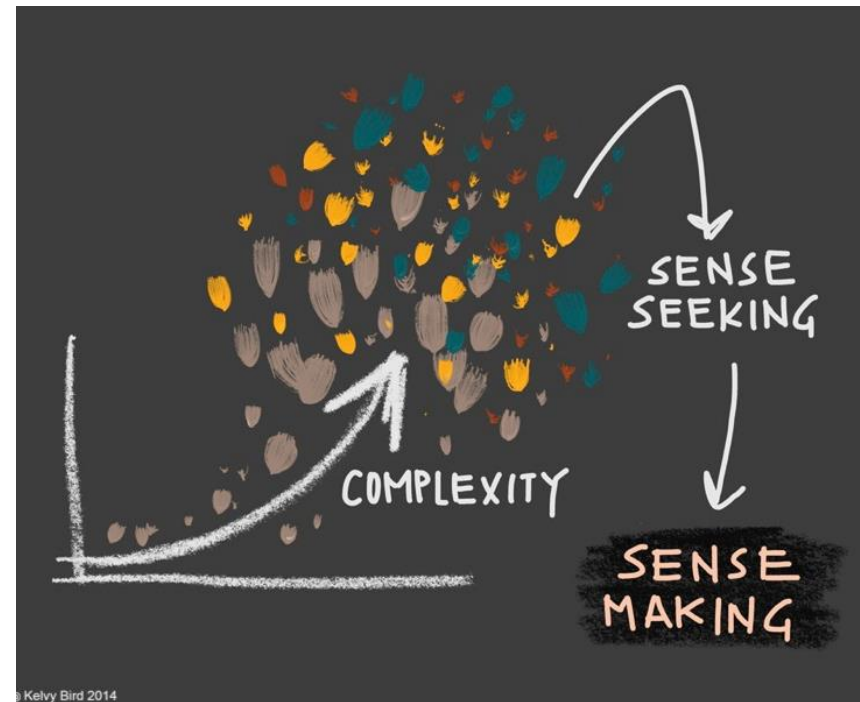

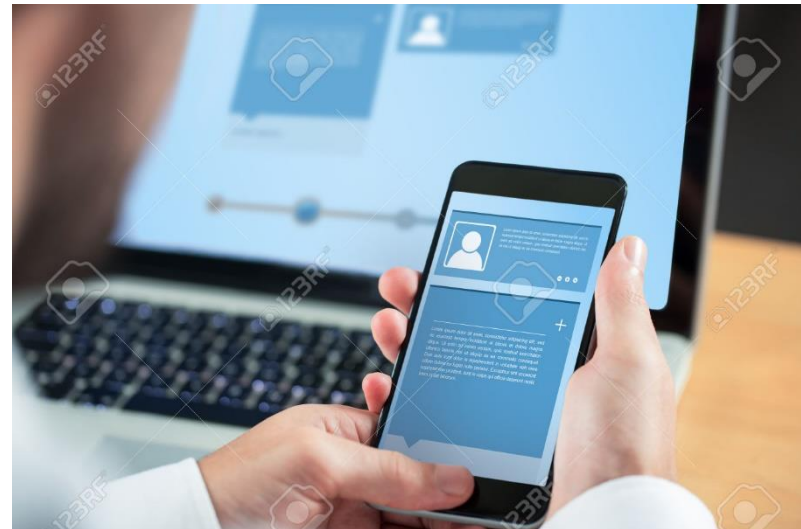
