## Opportunities for Biogas in Afghanistan

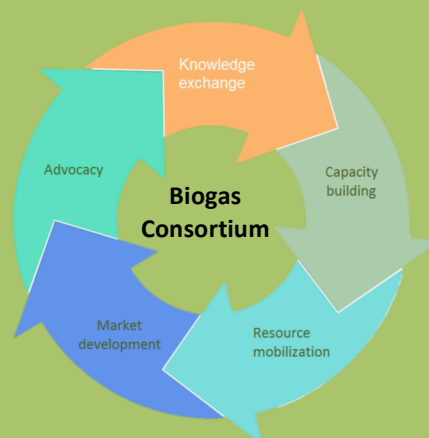
